Frequently Asked Questions

How many Cleaning Stations will I need?

- For fitness facilities, we suggest one Cleaning Station for every eight cardio machines, at least two in the strength area, and at least one per group activity room. The typical facility will average eight to twelve stations depending on the layout, the amount of equipment, usage, and membership size.
- For tanning salons and spas we recommend one in every room or at least several strategically located depending on the size of your business.
- For all other businesses, we recommend you select enough Cleaning Stations so they are conveniently located where usage is the heaviest.

Which supplies should I order each month?

Plan on using one case (six rolls) of towels per one or two stations per month, one hand sanitizer (1000ml) pack per station per month, and one dozen disinfectant packets per station per month.

Am I obligated to only buy the Clean Holdings supplies once I purchase the stations?

There is no obligation to purchase the supplies. The supplies have been selected to work together as a system and are priced very competitively. However, the Cleaning Station will only accept the Clean Holdings Hand Sanitizer refills.

Can I purchase just the towel and the hand sanitizer without the antibacterial cleaner?

Yes, you can order any of the supplies as you need them. We recommend that if you use your own disinfectants and spray bottles that they are properly labeled. OSHA recommends that MSDS sheets be kept in a central location accessible to all employees.

Can I use either dry or pre-moistened towels?

Yes, both types of towels will work simply by changing the included towel dispensing nozzle.

Does it matter which type of dry or pre-moistened towel is used?

The products sold by Clean Holdings work best but other towels will work. Contact us for more information .
